APPROVING THE PRIORITY AREAS OF RESEARCH AND (SOCIO-CULTURAL) DEVELOPMENT AND INNOVATION DEVELOPMENT (SMART SPECIALIZATION)

In implementing the Programme 2012–2016 of the Sixteenth Government, approved by Resolution No XII-51 of the Seimas of the Republic of Lithuania of 13 December 2012 (Official Gazette 2012, No 149-7630) as well as paragraph 4.3.1 of the Table on the progress of the implementation of the Activity Priorities 2013 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania, approved by Resolution No 318 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania of 10 April 2013 (Official Gazette 2013, No 40-1949), the Government of the Republic of Lithuania has resolved:

- 1. To approve the Priority Areas of research and (socio-cultural) development and innovation development (smart specialization) (appended).
- 2. To instruct the Ministry of Education and Science and the Ministry of Economy to submit, in coordination with the ministries concerned and with the consent of the Strategic Council for Research and Development and Innovation, the draft Programme on the implementation of the Priority Areas of research and (socio-cultural) development and innovation development (smart specialization) and their priorities to the Government of the Republic of Lithuania by 1 December 2003.
